

# Review Workshop for Certified Supply Chain Professional (CSCP) Atlanta, GA - Spring 2010

**The Deadline to apply for the June 2010 to July 2010 CSCP Exam window is three weeks prior to exam date.**

## **Supply Chain Management Fundamentals – Friday (April 30, 2010)**

This session will teach you to Explore how successful supply chain management adds value to your organization, to Learn how to develop a supply chain strategy that aligns with corporate strategy, and to Understand the importance of supply chain design and its evolving capabilities.

**Topics include:** Overview of Supply Chain Management (SCM), Supply Chain Management Strategy, Managing the Supply Chain, and Improving the Supply Chain.

## **Building Competitive Operations, Planning and Logistics – Friday (May 7, 2010)**

This session will teach you to Learn how to categorize customers based on their profiles and needs, to Establish measures of customer satisfaction, to Understand the strategic importance of purchasing and supplier relationships, and to Effectively use customer data to improve service performance and increase value to suppliers and customers.

**Topics include:** Relationship Management in SCM, Customer Relationship Management (CRM), Supplier Relationship Management (SRM), and Integrated Customer / Supplier Relationship Management.

## **Using Information Technology to Enable Supply Chain Management– Friday (May 21, 2010)**

This session will teach you to Learn how technology-enabled supply chains contribute to business strategies and operating plans, to Understand the innovative technologies enabling collaborative commerce and global visibility, and to Apply technology to enhance distribution, reverse logistics, and global supply chain communications.

**Topics include:** Role of Information Technology in the Supply Chain, ERP in supply Chain Management, innovative Technologies and Their Uses, Using IT to Enhance Supply Chain Performance, and e-Business.

This course will include the study materials recommended by APICS, including one year access to the LearnCSCP.com website with the Pre-test, tests for each Module and a Post-test, for self-assessment.

## Benefits of the CSCP Program

After earning your CSCP designation, you will

- Learn to boost productivity, collaboration, and innovation
- Discover how to positively affect lead times, inventory, productivity, and bottom-line profitability
- Understand how to manage the integration and coordination of activities to achieve reduced costs and increase efficiencies and customer service
- Gain the knowledge to effectively and efficiently manage worldwide supply chain activities
- Achieve greater confidence and peer and industry recognition
- Enjoy the potential for career advancement and increased earnings.

## Who should pursue the CSCP education and designation?

The CSCP program is for professionals in operations and supply chain management. This designation is ideal for you if you are

- Interested in more depth of knowledge and understanding in the areas of supplier and customer relations, international trade, the use of information technology to enable the supply chain, and physical logistics.
- A professional who is consulting or teaching supply chain functions
- Working with enterprise resources planning (ERP) systems.

## Earning Your APICS CSCP

To earn the APICS CSCP designation, candidates must pass one comprehensive four-hour exam. The exam will be administered in computer-based-testing, CBT, format in the following periods:

- March 13—April 10, 2010
- July 3—August 7, 2010
- December 4, 2010—January 15, 2011

## Becoming a CSCP Candidate

The CSCP examination is available to individuals who have relevant work experience and education. To be eligible for the CSCP exam, a candidate must meet **one** of the following criteria:

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent, plus two years of related business experience
- CPIM, CFPIM, CIRM, or C.P.M. designation plus two years of related business experience
- Five years of related business experience.

Individuals must submit an application documenting their eligibility to take the APICS CSCP exam.
