Fundamentals of Supply Chain Management – Saturday (February 25, 2012, and March 3, 2012)

This section addresses the fundamental concepts used for effective SCM and will provide the foundation for the APICS CSCP exam. It includes an overview of SCM concepts and the need to align resources with the strategy of the organization. Management and improvement of the supply chain are addressed.

Topics include: Supply Chain Management (SCM) Concepts, Alignment with Business Strategy, Design and Improvement Considerations, Inventory Management, Logistics Fundamentals, Market Segmentation, Demand Planning, Customer Relationship Management (CRM), and Supply Management Concepts.

Supply Chain Strategy, Design, and Compliance – Saturday (March 10, and March 17, 2012)

This section addresses considerations in the design of a competitive supply chain, the processes that support the organizations strategy, improvement of the sustainability of the organization and its trading partners, and compliance with applicable regulations.

Topics include: Sustainability, Risk Management, Globalization, Logistics, Managing the Supply Chain, Technology, Influencing and Prioritizing Demand, Customer Relationship Management (CRM), Supplier Relationship Management (SRM), and Inventory Planning and Control

Implementation and Operations – Saturday (March 24, 2012)

This section addresses managing and balancing supply and demand by measuring, analyzing, and improving supply chain processes.

Topics include: Supply Chain Dynamics, Managing Supply from Internal Sources, Managing Supply from External Sources, Implementation of Demand Plans, Continuous Improvement, .

This course will include the study materials recommended by APICS, including one year access to the LearnCSCP.com website with the Pre-test, tests for each Module and a Post-test, for self-assessment.

Students should request Eligibility to take the CSCP exam from APICS as soon as possible.

Earning Your APICS CSCP

To earn the APICS CSCP designation, candidates must pass one comprehensive four-hour exam. The exam will be administered in computer-based-testing (CBT) format in the following periods:

- April 7, 2012 through May 19, 2012
- June 30, 2012 through August 11, 2012
- December 1, 2012 through January 12, 2012

Becoming a CSCP Candidate

The CSCP examination is available to individuals who have relevant work experience and education. To be eligible for the CSCP exam, a candidate must meet one of the following criteria:

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent, plus two years of related business experience
- APICS' CPIM, CFPIM, CIRM, or ISM's C.S.C. M., C.S.M., or C.P.M. designation plus two years of related business experience
- Five years of related business experience.

Individuals must submit an **application** documenting their eligibility to take the APICS CSCP exam.
